Nearly 50% of all women have dense breasts (and many have no idea) and mammograms are only 50% effective in women with dense breasts. This is most concerning among women aged 30s-50s when women have the highest breast density, women of color who are diagnosed later and die sooner, and women who have served in the military who have twice the breast cancer rate. Mammograms are 98% effective in women without dense breasts and women with dense breasts deserve the same level of accuracy and effectiveness.
